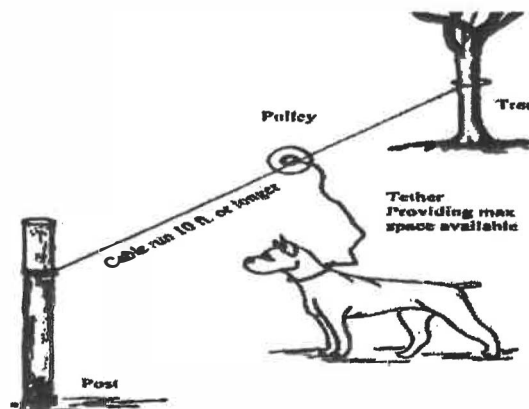

Is it legal to tie my dog up outside?

Only on a running cable line or trolley system and only one animal may be attached to each running cable or trolley system, no animal may be attached to a running cable line or trolley system for more than **12 hours** in a **24 hour** period.

No animal may be attached to a running cable line or trolley system between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.

Dogs on running cables must have access to adequate shelter, food and water as by law.

RECLAIM FEES

All fees are charged in accordance with Clayton County ordinance 14-253

CATS AND DOGS

First offense	\$50.00
Second offense	\$200.00
Third offense	\$300.00
Subsequent offenses	\$150.00

IN ADDITION TO THE ABOVE FEE, THE OWNER OF A DOG THAT HAS NOT BEEN SPAYED OR NEUTERED SHALL PAY AN ADDITIONAL FEE OF \$100.00 TO RECLAIM THE DOG(S)

OTHER ANIMALS

These fees are for each offense:

Rabbits, Poultry/ Birds	\$25.00
Other animal	\$50.00

IN ADDITION TO THE AFOREMENTIONED FEES, THE OWNER OF AN IMPOUNDED ANIMAL SHALL PAY A KENNEL FEE FOR EACH DAY THE ANIMAL IS BOARDED. THIS FEE IS \$10.00 PER DAY FOR CATS AND DOGS. OWNERS OF COWS, HORSES OR SIMILAR ANIMALS SHALL PAY A DAILY BOARDING FEE OF \$50.00 PER ANIMAL

HELP STOP RABIES

Protect your pets and home

- Keep your pets vaccinated
- Keep your pets restrained
- Avoid leaving pet food outside
- Do not touch, keep or feed wild animals
- Stay away from animals you don't know
- Report bats or other wild animals removed by trained wildlife removal personnel

What to do if you are bitten by your animal or a stray animal?

- Wash the wound thoroughly with soap and water
- Seek medical attention
- All bites from wildlife and unfamiliar domestic animals must be considered a possible exposure to the rabies virus
- Report the bite to Animal Control as soon as possible
- Use gloves when handling your pet, remember injured animals will bite

BARKING DOG COMPLAINT PROCEDURES

- ADVISE THE OWNER OF THE COMPLAINT, EITHER VERBALLY OR IN WRITING.
- DOCUMENT DATES, TIME, AND DURATION OF THE BARKING THIS MUST BE KEPT FOR 10 DAYS OR INCIDENT
- COME TO ANIMAL CONTROL TO REPORT THE INCIDENT AND COMPLETE A WRITTEN-STATEMENT. YOU MUST INCLUDE IN YOUR STATEMENT THE DOG'S DESCRIPTION AND THE ADDRESS WHERE THE DOG IS LOCATED.
- CITATIONS WILL BE ISSUED TO THE OWNER BASED ON YOUR DOCUMENTATION AND COMPLAINT.
- YOUR ATTENDANCE WILL BE REQUIRED IN COURT AT A LATER DATE.

PET OWNERSHIP

Owning a pet is a privilege, but the benefits of ownership come with responsibilities

- AVOID IMPULSIVE DECISIONS WHEN SELECTING.
- SELECT A PET THAT SUITED TO YOUR HOME AND LIFESTYLE
- COMMIT TO THE RELATIONSHIP FOR THE LIFE OF YOUR PET
- OWNERSHIP REQUIRES AN INVESTMENT OF TIME AND MONEY
- MAKE SURE YOUR PET RECEIVES PROPER PREVENTATIVE CARE AND MEDICAL ATTENTION WHEN NEEDED
- CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR PET
- LIMIT YOUR PET'S REPRODUCTION THROUGH SPAY/NEUTER, CONTAINMENT OR MANAGED BREEDING
- OBEY ALL STATE LAWS AND LOCAL ORDINANCES
