The Clayton County Adolescent Health and Youth Development (AHYD) Program was designed to enhance the skills and improve the health status of adolescents through opportunities and programs developed in collaboration with families, communities, schools and other public and private organizations throughout Clayton County. Programs and services target youth ages 10 to 19. The "Indicators of Youth Risk Behavior" are used to identify communities that have the greatest need for risk prevention and reduction.

AHYD works with various community partners to sponsor programs that reinforce positive attitudes and healthy behaviors, as well as activities aimed at decreasing youth violence, substance abuse, poor school performance, and early sexual activity. These AHYD programs provide a comprehensive and holistic approach with assisting our youth in the following ways:

Babies Can't Wait (BCW) is Georgia's comprehensive, coordinated, statewide, interagency service delivery system for families with infants and toddlers, ages birth to three, who have developmental delays or disabilities.

Eligibility: Must have children ages birth to three, who may be at risk or have developmental delays or disabilities.

Children 1st Program

Children 1st helps parents provide their young children (birth to age 5) with a healthy start in life, by identifying children at risk for poor health or development.

Eligibility: There are no financial requirements.

Children's Medical Services (CMS) Program

Children's Medical Services (CMS) provides comprehensive, community-based, family-focused, culturally appropriate medical/health care for eligible children, birth to 21, with chronic medical conditions.

Eligibility: Must have children with eligible conditions and meet financial requirements; children who are Medicaid/PeachCare enrolled, receive SSI, or are in foster care are eligible for services.

Healthier Generations Project (HGP)

Healthier Generations Project (HGP) offers care coordination to eligible pregnant women, new mothers, and children under the age of two. The specific components of HGP include (1) community and health promotion, (2) care coordination (including home visitation), (3) parenting education, (4) interconception care, (5) newborn care and support, and (6) comprehensive screenings, referrals, and linkage to other public health and community services. HGP also offers 24/7 DAD, a program which focuses on parenting and support services for fathers of children enrolled in HGP. So that, fathers can benefit and families are strengthened.

The program fuses the PAT's evidenced-based curriculum with the Resource Mothers concept to ensure that participants have healthy pregnancies and healthy babies. The program participants receive education, linkage to services, support, and social interaction in a group setting.

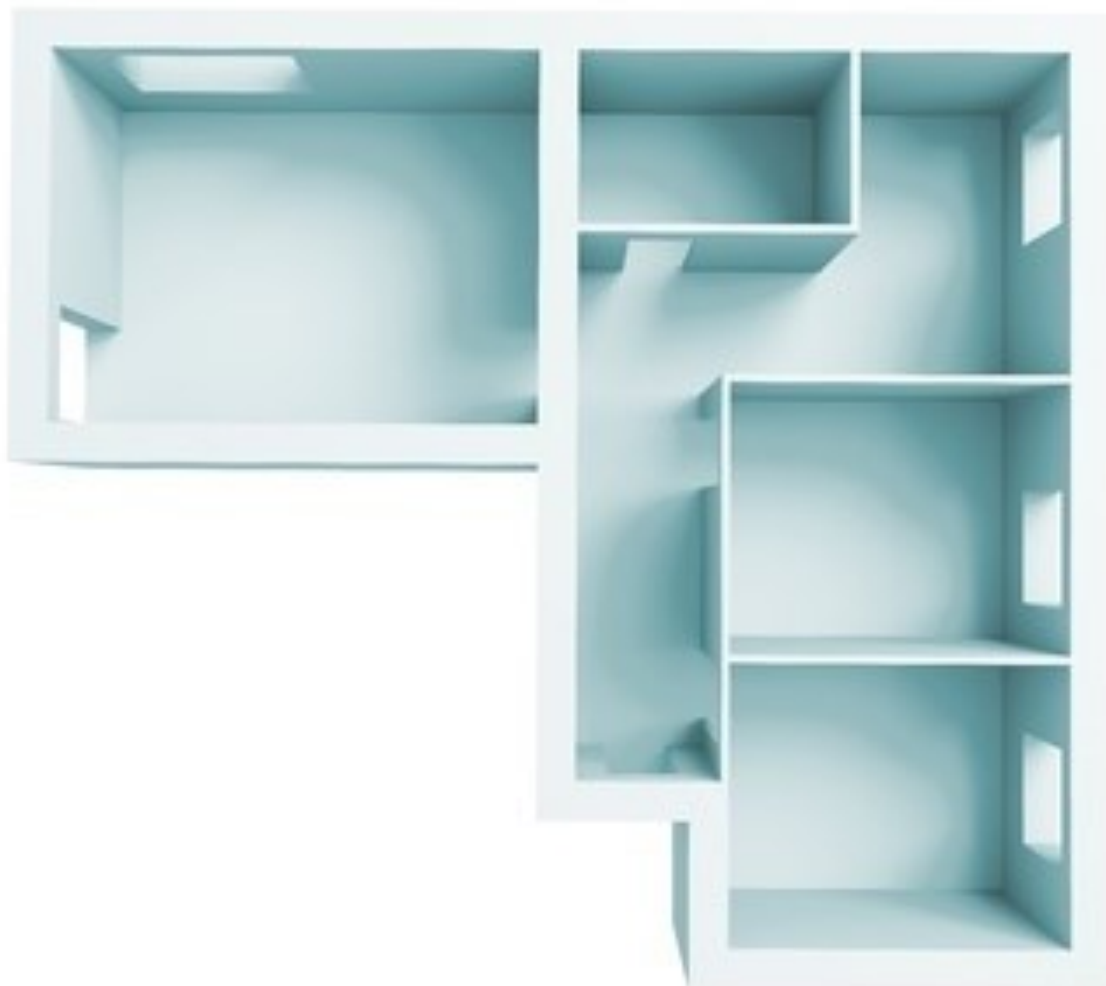
